

Privacy Policy

We welcome the coming into effect of the EU General Data Protection Regulation on 25 May 2018 and also of an ePrivacy Directive at a given time. We take the protection of your personal data very seriously and will comply with the rules of data protection laws to the best of our knowledge and belief. Personal data is collected on our web site only to the technically necessary extent. We treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the statutory data protection regulations and this privacy policy. Information collected will not be sold or shared with third parties.

This web site collects information that your browser sends to us and automatically stores it in its server log files. This includes e.g.:

- Browser type/version
- The operating system used
- Referrer URL (the previously visited page)
- Host name of the accessing computer (IP address)
- Time of the server request.

These data are saved only in anonymised form, therefore they cannot be therefore they cannot be assigned to any personally identifiable information by the owner of this web site.

The following declaration gives a simple overview of how we ensure privacy and what kind of data are collected to what purpose.

Contacting

During Contacting (e.g. via eMail) information of users are stored to process the request and sending answers in case of questions.

Application for membership

When we are receiving new members their personal data are processed for purpose of membership administration. What this means in specific is for registration of payment receipts of membership fees and for contacting members by association's board of directors. If applicable, data are used for solicitation of donations to promote achieving own goals of association. Moreover, the eMail address is stored in a mailing list to reach all members via a collective address for eMails. The members themselves can use this mailing list address to send messages to all other members without the knowledge of their own addresses. Personal data of members will not be shared with third parties or stored on servers located in third countries.

Right to information, data portability, correction and deletion

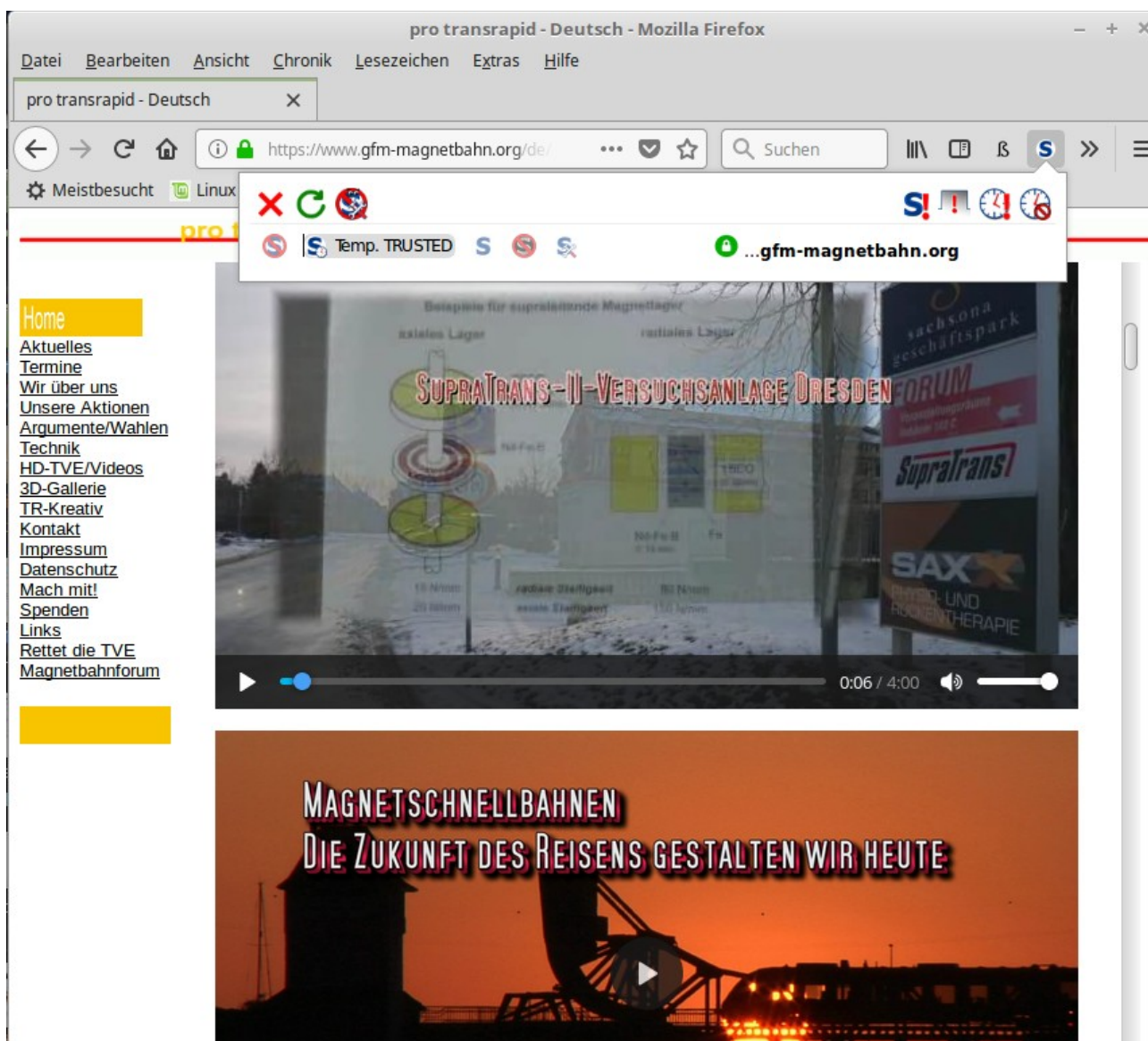

(No) cookies, analysis tools and third party tools

Our web pages are sponsored by membership fees. Therefore we do not use analysis tools and third party tools. Also, no cookies are stored when loading our web pages. There is no need to install for our web pages a JavaScript blocker (e.g. www.noscript.net or www.ghostery.com) for prevention of user tracking over the World Wide Web. But we highly recommend it when you go to other linked pages - for purpose of „digitalen self-defense“ against these tracker and against malicious code which could be placed onto web sites against the will of their owners by foreign hackers or against other kind of attacks.

Our pages are usable without enabled JavaScript execution. We do not use JavaScript libraries (js files) nor stylesheets (css files) nor fonts located on other servers. Execution of JavaScript is only needed for playback of embedded own videos using HTML5 standard. E.g. if you use NoScript for your browser, this works with the following setting:
